The following handbook outlines admissions, academics, billing and other details for our Global Campus Partnership. If you have any questions about the information provided below, please contact us. We are happy to answer any questions you may have. We are here to help!



Admissions Overview

- Students apply directly to the University of Arizona (UA). Both UA and partner university recruit students to the program.
- UA collects information from interested students through a request for information form (“RFI form”) posted on partner website. Leads from this form go to International Admissions at UA. Partner RFI forms are provided by our office and saved in Box for your convenience. Refer to sample RFI form, attached.
- Student information from RFI forms is entered into SLATE (CRM) and reports are generated weekly. These reports will be forwarded to partners. UA enrollment counselors connect with these students and guide them through our different programs, requirements, and admission processes. Partners may also contact prospective students from this list and provide guidance as well.
- UA enrollment counselors will work with students to complete their applications. Partners should be familiar with the application and required documents and be prepared to support students as needed.
- Partner admission counselors should be familiar with UA enrollment counselors and may work together to assist students.

Get to know UA Global Campus	Our key message is “everywhere you are, we are here for you.” Please visit our webpage everywhere.arizona.edu for a comprehensive list of our programs.
Enrollment Counselors	UA Enrollment Counselors will guide prospective students. Get to know the enrollment counselor for your region. Go to link and select your country to find your counselor.
Application	Prospective students can complete an application directly through our International Admissions Office. The application process takes about 20 minutes if students have all required documentation. Students are informed of admission decision within two weeks.
Application Deadlines	For Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 start dates
Country Requirements	Requirements vary by country. In general, prospective students will need 1) student records; 2) grade requirements equivalent to a B (or 12 out of 20), and 3) English proficiency exam. This link will provide you specific requirements for your country.
English Requirements	Accepted English proficiency exams and required scores. Note: Our Center for English as a Second Language’s English Proficiency Test (“CEPT”) is currently being offered at the reduced price of \$40 and can be done completely online. Please visit CEPT Exam for additional information.
Unofficial Transcripts	Unofficial Transcripts will suffice for the initial admission evaluation. Upon acceptance and before enrollment, official transcripts will be necessary. Transcripts should be in English.

Academics

Please note that American universities differ from many universities around the world in course requirements. Our curriculum is not 100% prescribed; rather, different programs have mandatory courses but also give students some options, or “elective courses”.

Transfer Credit

Students may be able to apply credits previously earned at another university towards their UA degree. UA enrollment counselors can answer initial questions and help begin this process.

New Student Orientation

Students will be required to participate in an online orientation where students will receive a variety of information including how to use UA systems, enroll in courses, set up their UA email account, how to use our digital learning platform, meet their academic advisor, and learn about UA resources.

Payment Deadlines for Fall 2020

Deadline to pay tuition for all units registered as of August 19th: August 24, 2020

Deadline to pay tuition for all units registered between August 20th and October 21st: October 26, 2020

Course Materials

Students are responsible for purchasing assigned course materials. Once students are enrolled in their courses, students will be able to access their required textbooks. Textbooks and/or materials can cost up to \$500 USD per semester.

Tuition Payment Plan

Making Tuition Payments

Students will be able to make international payments using a payment system called FlyWire. Global student success coaches will help students and parents use this system. Instructions are forthcoming.



Online Learning

How do online classes work?

University of Arizona online courses are offered asynchronously. This means that students can study at their own pace. Lectures are available to watch, and re-watch, at any time. Courses take place on our online learning platform called D2L.

Online courses encourage collaboration and community by making it easy for learners to connect, participate in forums and discussions, and interact with their professors and peers.

Professors provide timely and personalized in-the-moment feedback to encourage engagement and retention.

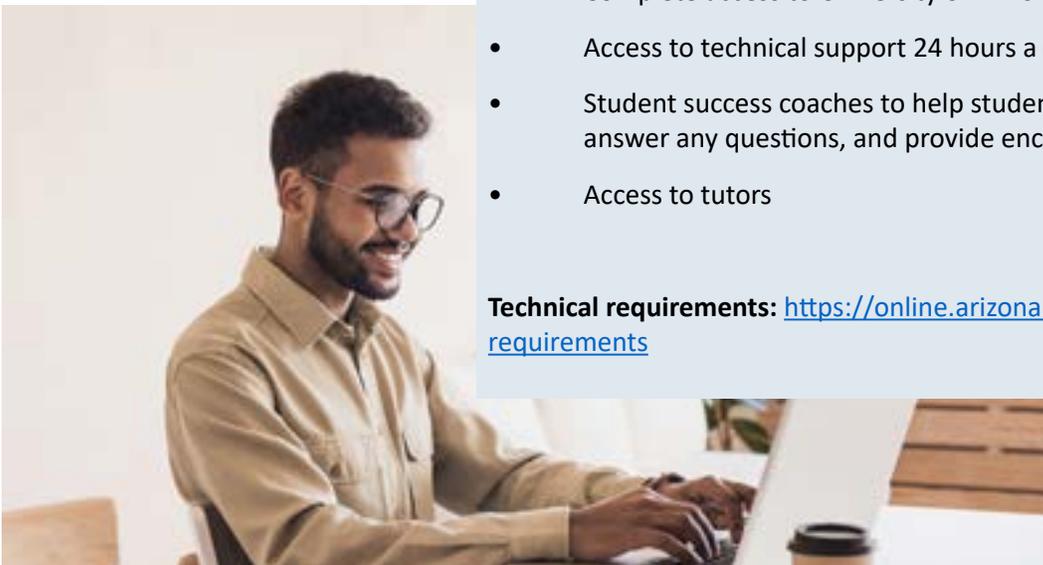
How to access an online classroom?
