Vietnam

Description

GEI Virtual Global Health 5-day Course in Vietnam is **co-designed with faculty** and offers students a unique opportunity to explore global and public health issues from a unique Asian perspective, highlighting how healthcare system in Vietnam deliver healthcare services, and exploring cultural interplays in urban and rural areas.

Students learn how communities are addressing their most pressing health challenges in the COVID 19 era and how Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) protocols in healthcare settings are implemented and enforced. The course is enriched with cross-cultural assessment and interaction tools, and with carefully planned cultural activities that allow students to have a memorable online experience.

Course Highlights

- **Explore** global health concepts and IPC protocols in cross-cultural settings.
- **Interact** virtually with local healthcare providers and local students to learn more about the Vietnamese healthcare system.
- **Learn** more about the hosting country, their history and the local culture through online sessions interacting with local hosts.
- **Gain** invaluable intercultural competence relevant to your field of study.
- **Incorporate** global learnings into local context through online activities.
